1:10 PM Addressing wildfire impacts and navigating the complex social and landscape driven challenges that a post-wildfire environment presents:

- Katie Lighthall, Western Region Coordinator for the <u>National Cohesive Wildland Fire</u> <u>Strategy</u> (chartered to the <u>Wildland Fire Leadership Council</u>, WFLC) has graciously agreed (on short notice) to join members and affiliates of the West Region Wildfire Council to share her knowledge, skills and expertise regarding this challenging topic.
- Additional colleagues and associates from Katie's professional circle may also be attending this meeting to share their perspectives depending upon availability.
- One goal of this agenda item is to learn more about the policy initiatives that WFLC and the <u>Western Governors Association</u> (WGA) have been spearheading regarding the variety of needs that arise after a community has experienced wildfire.
- A second goal of this agenda item is to initiate a discussion regarding our region's current capacity, through local/state/federal governments, agencies and NGO's, to effectively respond to the large number of complex needs that arise after the flames have died down and the incident management team passes-off authority back to the local agencies, org's and community at large.
 - The "<u>Colorado Post-Fire Playbook: Guidance for Counties, Tribes,</u> <u>Municipalities and Water Providers" (Feb 2021)</u> identifies a number of things that communities can and should be doing *ahead* of a wildfire. Do we have our post-fire playbooks at-the-ready? If not, should this be something that we are working on together?
